Confirmation at St Andrew's Tuesday 27 January, 7.30pm

Confirmation is a special church service in which a person confirms the promises that were made when they were baptised. If you were baptised at a christening when you were a child, your parents and godparents made these promises on your behalf. As a young person or adult, you may be ready to affirm these promises for yourself and commit your life to following Jesus Christ. At a confirmation service, you make these promises for yourself.

Your friends and family as well as the local Christian community will be there to promise to support and pray for you.

The Bishop of Hertford is coming to St Andrew's on Tuesday 27 January to conduct a Service of Confirmation. It's an incredibly powerful moment when the Bishop lays their hands on your head and ask God's Holy Spirit to give you the strength and commitment to become everything God made you to be.
